Over many years we have built up a wealth of knowledge and experience helping thousands of people in need to obtain sustainable livelihoods, so that they have enough food, medicine and education for themselves and their children and a life with more respect and dignity.

A ‘mighty atom’, APT is a small charity, running on very low overheads but with very big ambitions and widespread impact, it has a history of successful projects that really have transformed people’s lives.

We don’t give up on people. When our projects come to an end we are also leaving a lasting legacy.

MAKING A WILL

The best way to ensure that your family and loved ones will inherit is to make a Will. If you die intestate, you could be leaving them in the position of going through legal wrangles to establish their entitlement.

Through your Will you can also make a substantial gift to a charity. Inheritance Tax is payable by your estate on everything above the current threshold, except that which goes directly to your spouse. However, one way to reduce the tax liability is to make a gift to a charity as this is deducted from your estate before the tax assessment is made.

Please help. Every legacy APT Action on Poverty receives will help to give poor and vulnerable people the skills and knowledge to improve their lives.

When you make your Will you can leave a sum of money; stocks and shares; part or the whole of the residue of your estate.

- A Residual bequest. This is either the residue or part residue of your estate after all other legacies, taxes, debts and expenses have been paid
- A Pecuniary bequest, which is a legacy of a specific sum of money

When you have made a decision on your bequest you should use this wording in your Will:

Residual Bequest

‘I bequeath to APT Action on Poverty (registered charity no 290836) of Nicholas House, Heath Park, Main Road, Cropthorne, Worcestershire WR10 3NE (a – define portion/fraction) of the residue of my estate and I direct that the receipt of the Chief Executive of the Charity for the time being or other authorised officer will be sufficient discharge for my executors’

Pecuniary Bequest

If you decide to leave a specific amount to APT Action on Poverty and to ensure that inflation does not erode your generous intention when the Will is made, the following form of words could be used:

‘I bequeath to APT Action on Poverty (registered charity no 290836) of Nicholas House, Heath Park, Main Road, Cropthorne, Worcestershire WR10 3NE the sum of £__ inflation linked to the Retail Price Index from the date of this Will. I direct that the receipt of the Chief Executive of the Charity for the time being or other authorised officer will be sufficient discharge for my executors.

A Will is a legal document. To ensure your wishes will be carried out we strongly advise you seek advice from a solicitor.

If you have already made a Will, you can add to or change it at any time by way of a codicil.
